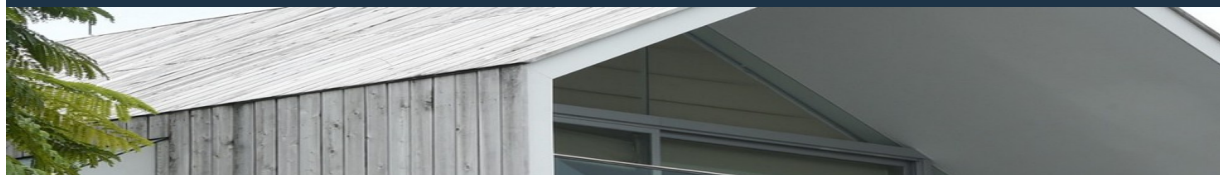


In the timber. Not on it.

A mineral silicate that is absorbed into the fibre and cures there, developing an even silver grey patina across the elevation. Nothing sits on the surface, so there is no film to chalk, craze or peel, and no stripping when it is renewed.

THE TIMBER STAYS TIMBER GRAIN AND TEXTURE UNCHANGED NO STRIPPING

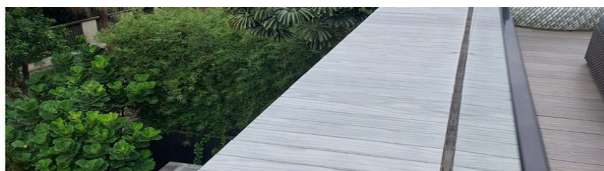


Twenty year old cedar siding revitalised with Patina+. Washed, rinsed, dried and treated in place — no sanding, no stripping, no replacement of sound timber.

IN THE TROPICS, A COATING IS ON A CLOCK

Ultraviolet, humidity and salt work on a film constantly, and the maintenance regime written into the specification is rarely followed to the level it needs. Two or three years in, the building looks worse than the day it opened, and the owner is facing a strip and recoat nobody budgeted for.

A silicate treatment inverts that. It keeps developing under the same ultraviolet and moisture that degrade a coating, so the building looks better in year five than in year one. That is not a laboratory claim: it is what six years in the Maldives has shown.

A coating also changes what you see. You specified timber, and the building shows a film over timber.

Patina+ is absorbed and mineralises within the fibre. Grain, texture and tactility are unchanged, and the failure mode is benign: a treatment due for renewal simply looks like weathered timber, which is what it is.

Patina rate depends on species, orientation and exposure. Sheltered elevations develop more slowly. Where a specific rate matters, we run a trial panel in the actual exposure before the full application is specified.

It goes on new timber and on old timber alike. A facade before handover, or a building standing twenty years. The treatment does not change. Only the preparation in front of it does.
